



Ultrasound-guided carpal tunnel release lowers risk of nerve injury

Thread ultrasound-guided carpal tunnel release (TCTR) uses an abrasive thread looped percutaneously to dissect the TCL. This procedure offers people quicker pain relief and recovery than conventional open carpal tunnel releases.

Bipolar enucleation treats large prostate gland without incisions

Bipolar enucleation of the prostate can treat benign prostatic hyperplasia primarily in patients with prostates larger than 80 mL or those who experience urinary retention. The adenoma of the prostate is removed without incisions.
