Minimum package of services should include primary care, preventive care and coordination of care



Multiple levels of evidence-based essential services



Use an independent health board to provide evaluation of services



Shared responsibility / affordable / the amount you pay is a function of your ability to pay



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Pricing and cost accountability, transparency



Maintain a choice of provider



Ability to purchase services above the minimum package



Consumers should be provided with user-friendly, evidence-based information about their health care options



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Create incentives (structured) for healthy lifestyle choices and adhering to treatment protocols.



Assure the maximum number of people are insured thru private plans of their choice

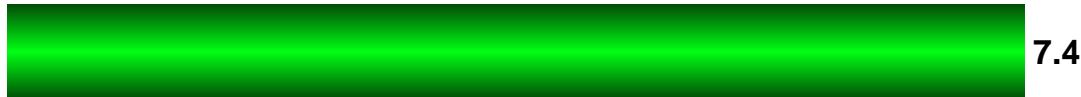


Plans must work for the small employer
