Influenza Vaccination at Mayo Clinic

Beginning January 4, H1N1 and seasonal influenza vaccinations will be available by appointment at Mayo Clinic Employee and Community Health locations and the Immunization Clinic. Mayo Clinic patients with an established primary care physician should call their primary care location for an appointment. Mayo Clinic patients who do not have a primary care physician should call the Immunization Clinic if they are 16 years old or older, or Baldwin Community Pediatric and Adolescent Medicine if they are younger than 16.
