

Cardiovascular Mayo Clinic Hospital Phoenix Campus

Overview

This is a 36 bed unit serving both a medical and surgical patient population with a focus on cardiology, cardiovascular surgery, heart transplant, thoracic and pulmonary care.

- All patient rooms are private and have both hardwire and telemetry monitoring capability
- Shared governance model with active Unit Based Practice Team led by staff nurses
 - Research, Quality and Social Subcommittees on the unit
- Assignments are made using an acuity based system. Typical assignments are:
 - 3 patients per RN on days
 - 3 – 4 patients per RN on nights
- All RN staff; nursing assistants are also a part of our team
- **Shift Team Leader**, who does not take patients, as a staff nurse resource
- **Dedicated Unit based educator**
- Cardiovascular pharmacist on the unit during business hours
- Heart failure **clinical nurse specialist** and heart transplant clinical nurse specialist as resources
- **Dedicated RN case manager** and social worker to arrange complex discharges
- Telemetry monitoring is done using GE Statview paging technology – the RN is responsible for the monitoring of her/his patients.
- Electronic medical record – all charting is done on the computer
- Unit nursing staff does self-scheduling
- Medical diagnoses can include:
 - congestive heart failure
 - status post MI/chest pain
 - uncontrolled hypertension
 - care of patients on ventricular assist devices
 - dysrhythmias
 - cardiomyopathy
 - syncope
 - care of patients with short term diagnostic PA catheters

- Surgical and procedural diagnoses can include status post:
 - heart transplant
 - vascular surgery
 - valvular surgery
 - pacemaker implantation
 - radio-frequency ablation/
electrophysiology procedures
 - angioplasty
 - thoracotomy
 - esophagogastrectomy
 - coronary artery bypass grafting
 - gastric bypass surgery

Shift options

- 12 hour day/night shifts with every other weekend
- Flexible alternative shift options
- Full-time/Part-time/Supplemental/ PRN

Requirements

- Compact State or current Arizona RN license required upon date of hire
- Experience in cardiovascular nursing preferred
- ACLS expected within 1 year of hire
- BLS required
