

# Endoscopy Mayo Clinic Hospital Phoenix Campus

## Overview

The Endoscopy Department at Mayo Clinic Hospital provides care to the Inpatient and Outpatient population for Gastroenterology, Hepatology, and Pulmonary Services.

The Endoscopy Department has four procedure rooms, with one room dedicated to anesthesia and fluoroscopy. The department performs approximately fifteen procedures daily.

Procedures performed in Endoscopy are:

- Bronchoscopy
- Colonoscopy
- Double Balloon Colonoscopy
- Double Balloon Enteroscopy
- Enteroscopy
- EGD
- ERCP
- Esophageal Video Capsule
- Flexible Sigmoidoscopy
- Liver Biopsy
- Radio Frequency Ablation of the Esophagus
- Photo Dynamic Therapy of the Esophagus
- Small Bowel Video Capsule
- Stent Placement (Biliary, Esophageal, Colonic)
