

Float Pool Mayo Clinic Hospital Phoenix Campus

Overview:

The Float Pool at Mayo Clinic Hospital supports a multitude of nursing services and patient populations. Mayo Clinic Hospital has 244 licensed beds including 224 medical/surgical/tele beds, 20 ICU/CCU beds and 7 rehabilitation beds. The hospital provides inpatient care to support the 65 medical and surgical specialties and programs of Mayo Clinic. The Float Pool provides its staff with a challenging work environment with supportive education to meet the needs of all patient populations encountered. The Float Pool supports all inpatient medical/surgical/intermediate care beds and floats to ancillary departments as well. Orientation is provided in all care areas to achieve competency and to provide the “Best Nursing Care in the World”.

- All patient rooms are private and have telemetry monitoring capability
- Telemetry monitoring is done using GE Statview paging technology – the RN is responsible for the monitoring of her/his patients.
 - Opportunity to take basic/advance ECG class
 - ACLS is offered and require upon 90 days of hire
- Encouraged to join hospital based practice committees.
 - Quality, Research, and Education.
- Assignments are made using an acuity based system. Typical assignments are:
 - 3-4 patients per RN on days and 4-5 patients per RN on nights
 - RN primary care and RN/PCA model used
- **Team Leaders**, with no patient assignment, serve as a clinical resource for the staff. Team Leaders are assigned to overflow areas when holding patients.
- Dedicated **Unit Based Educator** to assist with meeting educational needs and opportunities.
- **Pharmacist** on the units during business hours and centralized during nights.
- **Clinical nurse specialists** available as a resource specific to patient populations.
- Dedicated **RN case managers** and **Social Workers** to arrange complex discharges.
- Electronic medical record-keeping – all charting is done on the computer
- Float Pool staff does self-scheduling
 - Flexible scheduling
- Patient population expected to care for includes:

- Medical
- General Surgical
- Intermediate care patients
- Telemetry (non-cardiac and cardiac)
- Emergency room
- Specialized surgical patients
 - ENT, GYN, orthopedics, urology, plastics, cardiovascular, neurosurgical, transplant, and ect.
- Oncology/Hematology
- Overflow care areas for holding patients.

Shift options

- 8 and 12 hour day/night shifts with every other weekend
- Fulltime/Part-time/Supplemental
- Flexible alternative shift options

Requirements

- Compact State or current Arizona RN license required upon date of hire
- One year experience acute care nursing
- BLS required within 30 days of hire
- ACLS required within 90 days for hire
