

Hematology/Oncology/Bone Marrow Transplant Unit Mayo Clinic Hospital Phoenix Campus

Overview

This is a 30 bed unit serving both a medical and surgical patient population with a focus on hematology, oncology, and bone marrow transplant.

- All patient rooms are private and have telemetry monitoring capability
- Shared governance model with active Unit Based Practice Team led by staff nurses
- Assignments are made using an acuity based system. Typical assignments are:
 - 3 - 4 patients per RN on days
 - 3 - 4 patients per RN on nights
- All RN staff; nursing assistants are also a part of our team
- **Shift Team Leader**, who does not take patients, as a staff nurse resource
- **Dedicated Unit Based Educator**
- Oncology pharmacist on the unit during business hours
- Oncology **clinical nurse specialist** and solid organ transplant clinical nurse specialist as resources
- **Dedicated RN case manager** and social worker to arrange complex discharges
- Telemetry monitoring is done using GE Statview paging technology – the RN is responsible for the monitoring of her/his patients.
- Electronic medical record-keeping – all charting is done on the computer
- Unit nursing staff does self-scheduling
- Medical/Surgical diagnoses in this unit can include:
 - Hematology malignancy
 - Oncology – chemotherapy and symptom management
 - Bone marrow transplant (SCT/BMT)
 - Pain control
 - Brachytherapy
 - Post transplant – symptom management

Shift options

- 12 hour day/night shifts with every other weekend
- Flexible alternative shift options
- Full-time/Part-time/Supplemental/ PRN

Requirements

- Compact State or current Arizona RN license required upon date of hire
- Experience in hematology/oncology/transplant nursing preferred
- Chemotherapy ONS Provider within 1 year of hire
- BLS required
