

Outpatient Infusion Department Mayo Clinic Hospital Phoenix Campus

Overview

The Outpatient Infusion Department (OPIV) provides treatment to patients requiring care in the outpatient setting. Services are provided from 7:00am - 11:00pm, Monday through Friday and 7:00am - 7:00 pm, Saturday and Sunday. The department has 10 treatment and procedural bays. The OPIV nurses are specialty educated in placement of peripherally inserted central catheters (PICC), accessing of intravascular access devices, assessment of surgically implanted central lines, and the care and maintenance of all central lines. Additional services performed in OPIV include:

- Chemotherapy infusion
- Therapeutic phlebotomy
- Infusion of antibiotics, parenteral nutrition, hydration
- Transfusion of blood products
- Stem cell apheresis
- Injections and central line lab draws
- Bone marrow biopsy

Shift options

- 12 hour day/evening shifts with every third weekend
- 6, 8, 10 hour shifts
- Fulltime/Part-time/Supplemental/PRN

Requirements

- Compact State or current Arizona RN license required
- 2-3 years experience as an oncology or infusion nurse
- OCN certification preferred
- Chemotherapy certification preferred
