Each part of your brain helps your body do AMAZING things!

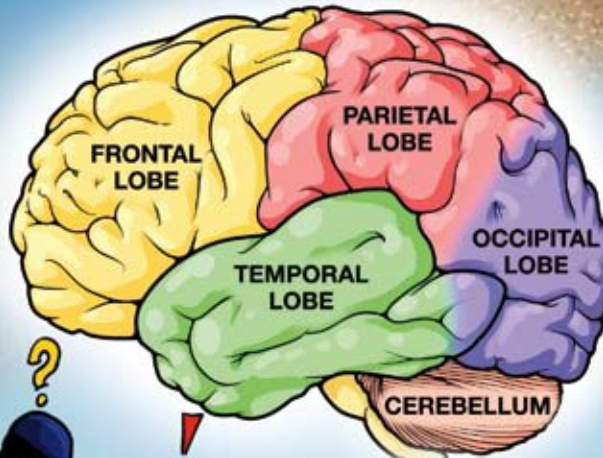
Use this card to learn how your brain works, and how it helps baseball players do all the things they do!



The frontal lobe controls your muscles. It is used to throw a strike or run the bases.



The parietal lobe provides feeling in your body. It tells you that you're in pain if you get hit by a pitch!



The occipital lobe provides vision. It lets you see the ball to hit a home run!



The temporal lobe helps with speech and memory. It allows you to talk to your coach and understand what he's saying.



The cerebellum helps give you coordination. It helps you to swing a bat, dive to catch a ball, or steal 2nd base!
