	SHRINK. THEY'RE BASICALLY STRANGULATED AND THEY FALL OFF."
	IT'S A PROCEDURE THAT MAYO CLINIC DR. MARK LARSON SAYS CAN BE DONE RIGHT IN A PHYSICIANS OFFICE. BUT SOMETIMES, EVEN THIS ISN'T ENOUGH.
Dr. Larson	"THEN A CONSULTATION WITH A COLORECTAL OR A GENERAL SURGEON MAY BE REQUIRED, TO ACTUALLY SURGICALLY REMOVE THE HEMORRHOIDAL VEINS."
	BUT EVEN THAT IS NO GUARANTEE THAT NEW HEMORRHOIDS WON'T APPEAR. SO IT'S IMPORTANT TO ADDRESS THE FACTORS THAT ARE CAUSING THEM IN THE FIRST PLACE.
