Mr. Tomm is the managing partner and CEO of Pablo River Partners in Jacksonville, Florida. Previously, he was president and CEO of Brumos Automotive (Mercedes-Benz, Porsche and Lexus) in Jacksonville until its sale in early 2016. Prior to entering the retail automotive industry in 1994, he was executive vice president and COO of PIE Nationwide (trucking), an investment banker, deputy general counsel of Schlumberger Limited (oil field services), vice president and general counsel of Arkansas Best Corporation (trucking), adjunct professor of law at the University of Arkansas, and in the private practice of law with Winthrop, Stimson, Putnam and Roberts (now Pillsbury Winthrop Shaw Pittman).

He is a former trustee of Washington & Lee University and of HabiJax (Habitat for Humanity in Jacksonville); a trustee and board chair of Jacksonville University; a trustee of The Bolles School; chair of the Jacksonville Sports Council; and a former lacrosse coach at Bolles. He served from 1968-72 as a diver and officer on the U.S. Navy's only troop-carrying submarine and earned the Navy Achievement, Vietnam Service, Vietnam Campaign and National Defense medals.
