Christina Zorn, J.D., is the chief administrative officer of Mayo Clinic, a large nonprofit national and international academic health system. With a workforce of 78,000, Mayo Clinic earns \$16.3 billion in annual revenue while caring for about 1.3 million patients each year from all 50 states and nearly 130 countries.

In partnership with Gianrico Farrugia, M.D., Ms. Zorn provides leadership and oversight for Mayo Clinic. Ms. Zorn is responsible for administrative functions in the clinical practice, research, education and Mayo Clinic Platform, as well as in enterprise shared services, including communications, development, enterprise risk management, facilities, finance, human resources, information technology, security and strategy.

Prior to her appointment as chief administrative officer, Ms. Zorn served as vice chair of Administration, Mayo Clinic, and chief administrative officer of Mayo Clinic in Florida. She began her career at Mayo in 2002 as a legal counsel. In 2009, she was named chair of the Florida division of Mayo Clinic's Legal Department.

Ms. Zorn is a member of the Mayo Clinic Board of Trustees and Governors, and serves on the Mayo Clinic Finance and Investment and the Mayo Clinic Digital Solutions subcommittees. She serves on the Mayo Clinic Executive Operations Team, Mayo Clinic Administrative Team, Mayo Clinic Administrative Team Executive Committee, Mayo Clinic Security Committee, and Mayo Clinic Salary and Benefits Administrative Subcommittee.

Ms. Zorn earned a Bachelor of Science in zoology from the University of Wisconsin and received her Juris Doctor degree from Creighton University School of Law. Prior to joining Mayo Clinic, she practiced with the law firm Foley & Lardner, focusing on healthcare and transactional law.

Ms. Zorn represents Mayo Clinic on various advisory groups within the American Hospital Association and the Healthcare Leadership Council. She is also a member of the American Association of Corporate Counsel, the American Health Lawyers Association and the American College of Healthcare Executives.
