Dr. Rihal is a board-certified cardiologist with subspecialty certification in interventional cardiology. He specializes in seeing patients with complex heart disease with a focus on providing minimally invasive therapies for valve and structural heart disease. He has pioneered and developed many of these procedures in collaboration with colleagues at Mayo Clinic. Active in education and research, Dr. Rihal is a recipient of numerous teaching awards and has published over 500 manuscripts in the peer-reviewed literature.

Dr. Rihal joined the Mayo Clinic staff in 1995 and was director of the Cardiac Catheterization Laboratory from 2003 to 2010, Chair of the Department of Cardiovascular Medicine from 2010 to 2017 and currently chairs the Mayo Clinic in Rochester Personnel Committee. Dr Rihal's interests include business strategy and workforce and leadership development.

Dr. Rihal has a degree in business from the Carlson School of Management, University of Minnesota, and a Diploma in Strategy and Innovation from the University of Oxford.
