[Bowel prep study examines use of medications with patient positioning](#)

A Mayo Clinic study investigates the use of comprehensive purgative preparation combined with right lateral positioning.

A Mayo Clinic study used computer modeling to compare different approaches for COVID-19 testing in patients requiring semi-urgent and elective endoscopies.
