Dr. Abimbola Famuyide is Professor of Obstetrics and Gynecology at Mayo Clinic Rochester. He has been a consultant at Mayo Clinic for over 22 years. Dr. Famuyide completed medical school at the University of Ibadan, Nigeria and OB/GYN residency training in England and Mayo Clinic in Rochester. He is board certified in obstetrics and gynecology with focused practice certification in minimally invasive gynecologic surgery by the American Board of Obstetrics and Gynecology. His areas of interest include outcomes research in abnormal uterine bleeding, benign gynecologic endoscopic surgery and obstetric safety.

Dr. Famuyide has served as Chair of the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology, Chair of the Division of Gynecology, Chair of the Division of Obstetrics, and Vice Chair of Practice & Quality within the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology and has chaired several enterprise leadership search committees. He currently serves as Chair of Mayo Clinic in Rochester Personnel Committee.
