Eric J. Moore, M.D., is the medical director of International at Mayo Clinic. He is also a professor and chair of the Department of Otolaryngology at Mayo Clinic in Rochester. As department chair, Dr. Moore leads Mayo Clinic's efforts to provide care for patients with complex ear, nose and throat (ENT) needs, fostering a diverse and inclusive organization committed to excellence in clinical care, education and research.

With more than 30 years of experience in head and neck surgery, Dr. Moore has spearheaded the implementation of subspecialty care clinics for head and neck surgery. His joint appointments in the Department of Neurosurgery, Department of Pediatrics, and Division of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery in the Department of Surgery ensure better-coordinated treatments for ENT patients. Dr. Moore's clinical interests include intraoperative tumor resection and the treatment of head and neck cancers, where he has pioneered efforts in less invasive transoral robotic surgery (TORS).

Dr. Moore attended medical school at Jefferson Medical College, completed his residency in otolaryngology-head and neck surgery at Mayo Clinic from 1992 to 1997 and pursued a fellowship in endoscopic skull base surgery in Graz, Austria, in 2001. He served as a major in the United States Air Force from 1997 to 2001 and began his clinical practice in head and neck surgery at Mayo Clinic in 2001.
