Amy K. Hara, M.D. is Professor and Chair for the Department of Radiology at Mayo Clinic Arizona since 2015 and Enterprise Radiology Specialty Council Chair since 2019. She has been on staff at Mayo Clinic Arizona for over 20 years.

Her current roles include Medical Director of both
Enterprise Strategic Pricing and Center of Digital Health
– Practice Enablement. She has served on the MCA
Executive Operations Team since 2016. Prior roles include
co-chair of large facility projects in Arizona including
Proton Beam and the Mayo Clinic Hospital South
Expansion. She is currently a member of the Arizona.Bold.
Forward committee.

A native of Missouri, Dr. Hara attended a 6-year combined BA-MD program at the University of Missouri in Kansas City, Missouri. She was a part of the Clinical Investigator Program at Mayo Clinic Rochester for 2 years. During that time, her team published the first clinical article using virtual colonoscopy/CT Colonography and patented this technology which is in clinical use today. She completed her radiology residency training at Mayo Clinic Rochester and her fellowship in abdominal imaging at Mallinckrodt Institute of Radiology, Washington University in St. Louis, MO.

Dr. Hara has over 100 published articles. Her research focus has been imaging of inflammatory bowel disease, colon screening with CT and CT radiation dose. She is on the Board of Directors for the Society of Abdominal Radiology and incoming president in 2023.
