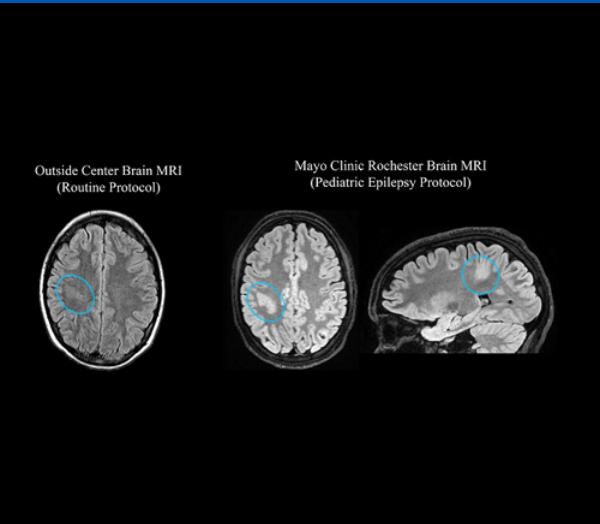

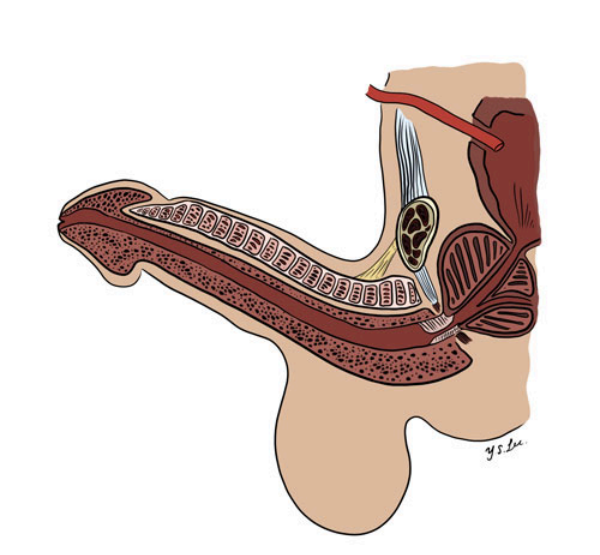

Mayo Clinic first to offer specialized transluminal techniques for urethral strictures

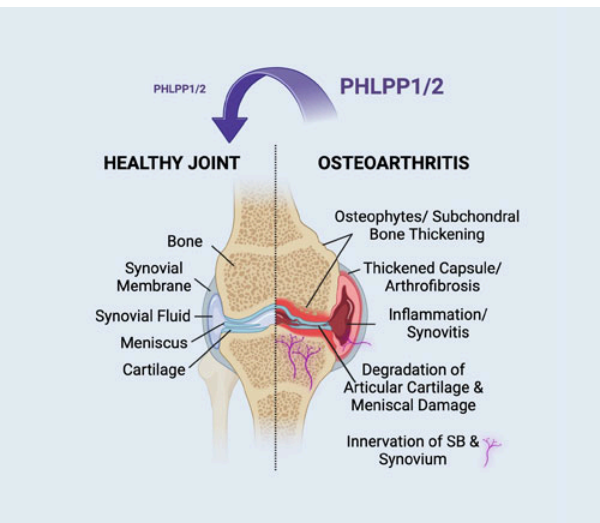

Turning the ship around on degeneration

Jennifer J. Westendorf, Ph.D., researches the use of Phlpp inhibitors to slow processes leading to degeneration, using post-traumatic osteoarthritis as a model. She hopes to collaborate with surgeons fixing instability to reboot joint cells pharmacologically.
