Surgical alternatives when ileal J-pouch is not possible

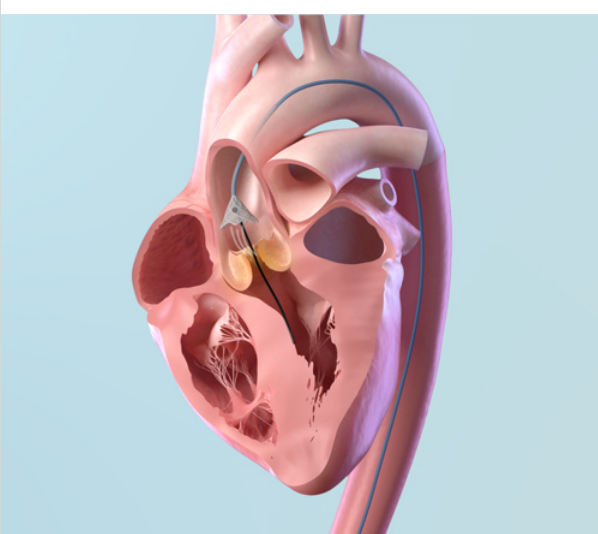
