Precision targeting, reduced side effects: Proton beam therapy for pediatric cancers

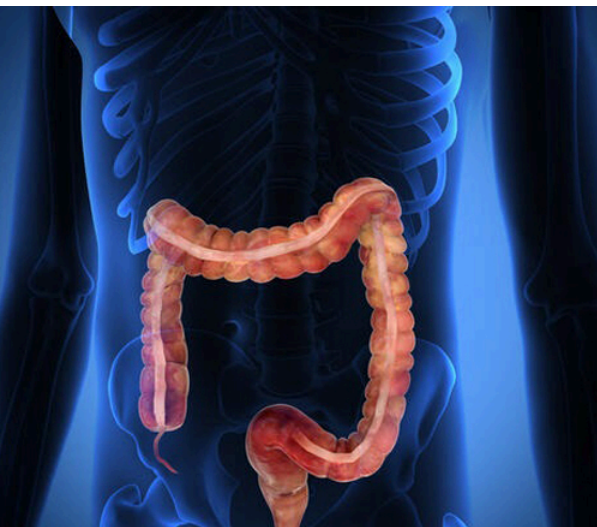
