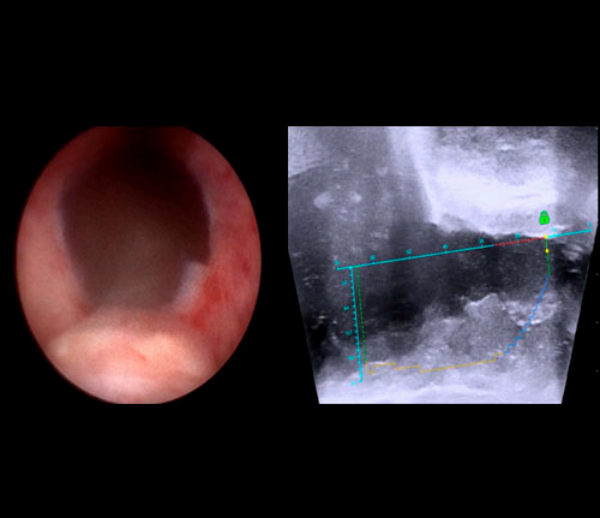

Aquablation procedure for benign prostatic hyperplasia (BPH)

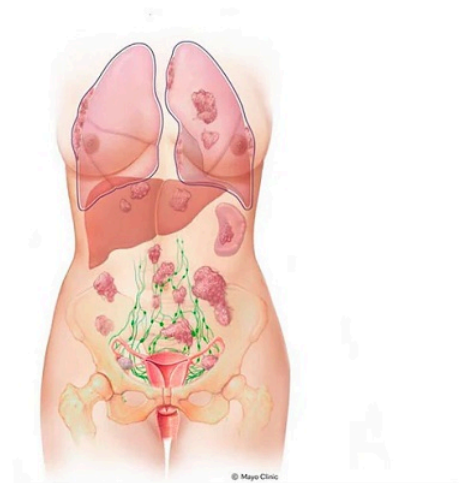
