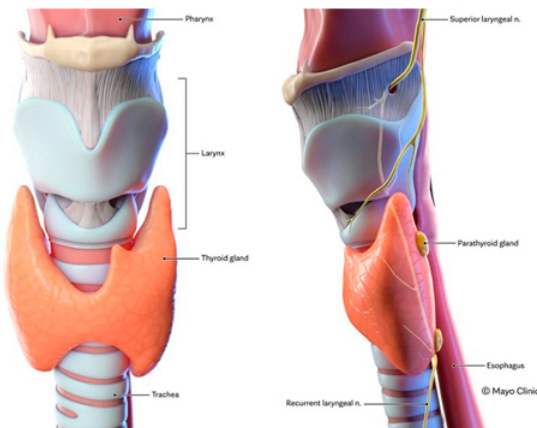

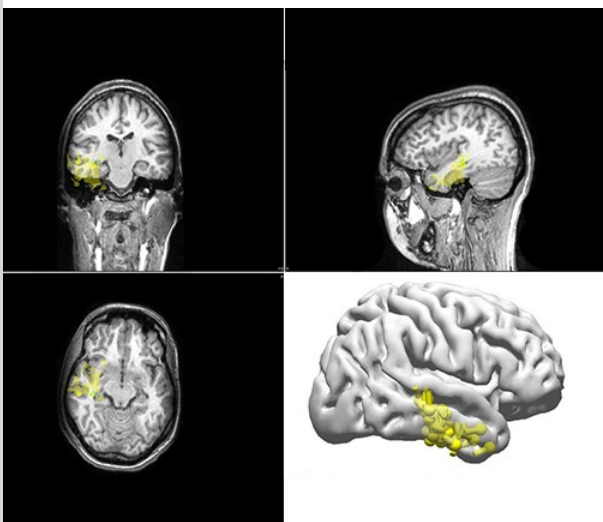

MEG helps verify seizure origin sites

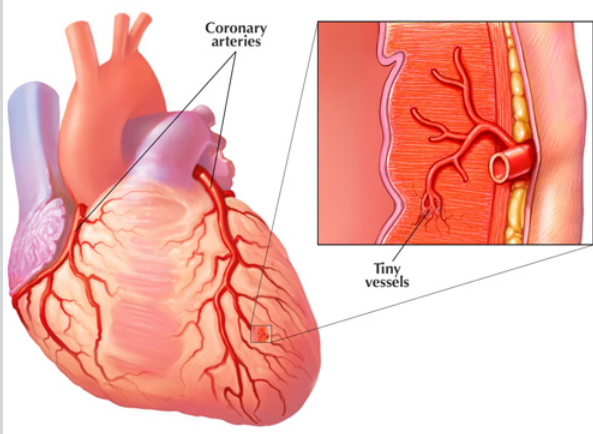
