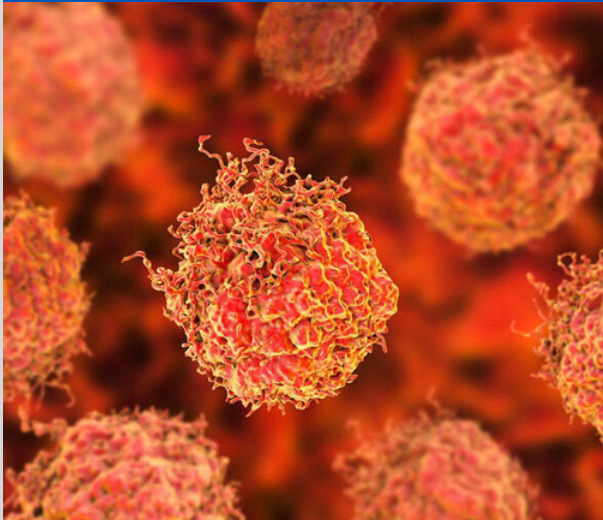

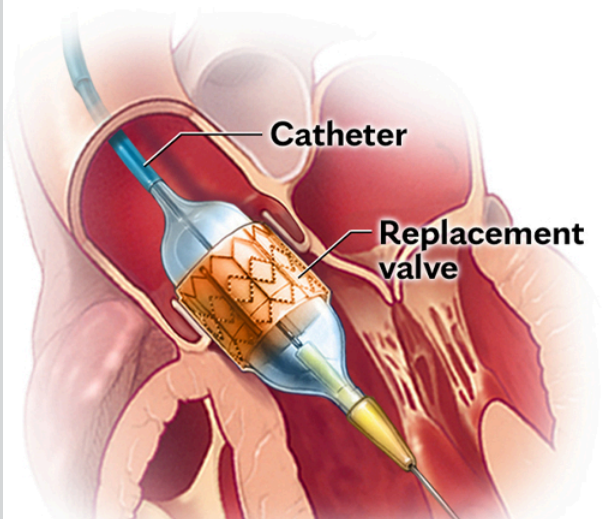

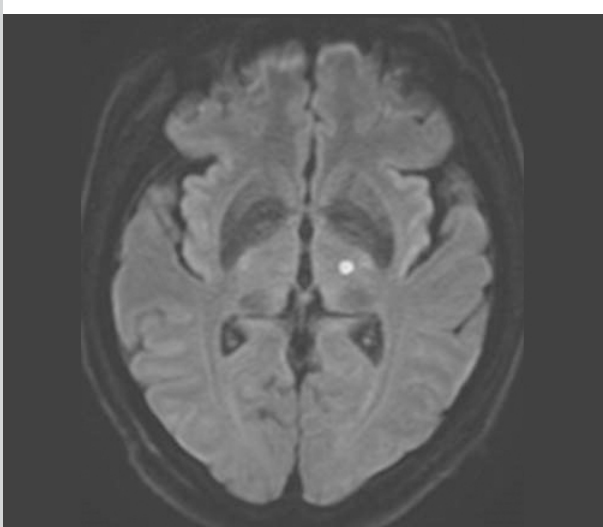
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When to consider transcatheter aortic valve replacement (TAVR) or a surgical valve
