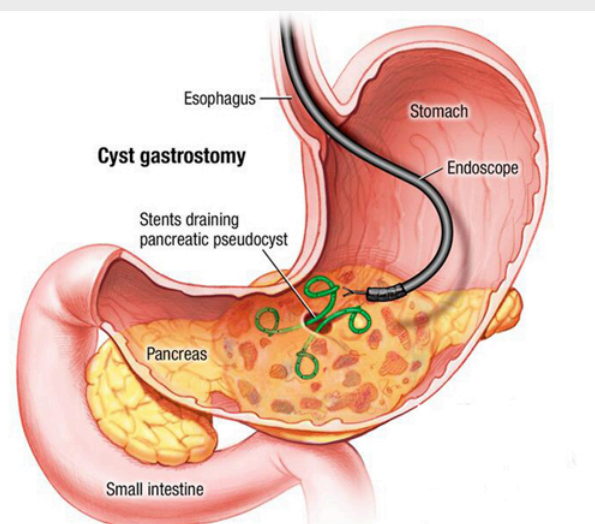

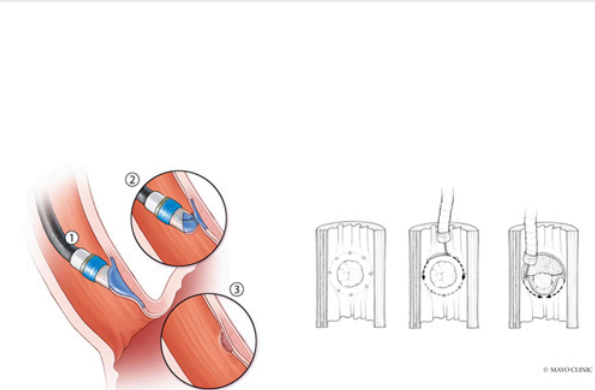

Study compares Barrett's esophagus and dysplasia recurrence rates after complete remission in patients treated with EMR versus ESD

Endoscopic mucosal resection (EMR) and endoscopic submucosal dissection (ESD) appear to have comparable rates of Barrett's esophagus (BE) or dysplastic BE recurrence.

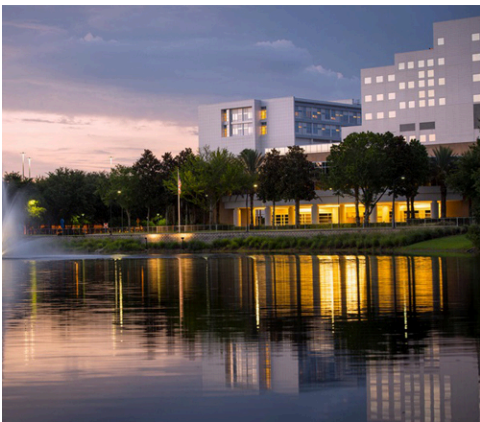
