Sens. Klobuchar, Franken Visit Mayo Rochester Campus

Minnesota Sens. Amy Klobuchar and Al Franken spent part of their August recess at Mayo Clinic's Rochester campus. Sen. Klobuchar participated in a roundtable discussion on health care reform with Mayo physicians and health care professionals on Aug. 7. She heard about examples of pay for value in practice at Mayo, and said that she would share the information with her colleagues when she returned to Washington. Sen. Franken toured Mayo facilities and heard about how Mayo works with the surrounding community to ensure quality health care and a strong economic base in southeastern Minnesota.

Mayo Alumni Meet with Members in Home Districts

In August, Mayo Clinic alumni physicians met with over a dozen members of Congress and/or their staffs to share their views on health care reform. Alumni met with representatives in Arizona, Iowa, Massachusetts, Oregon, Florida, and Utah. The physicians talked about how reforms, such as improving access and paying for value, will improve the quality of health care. Additional meetings among alumni and their members of Congress will continue into the fall.
