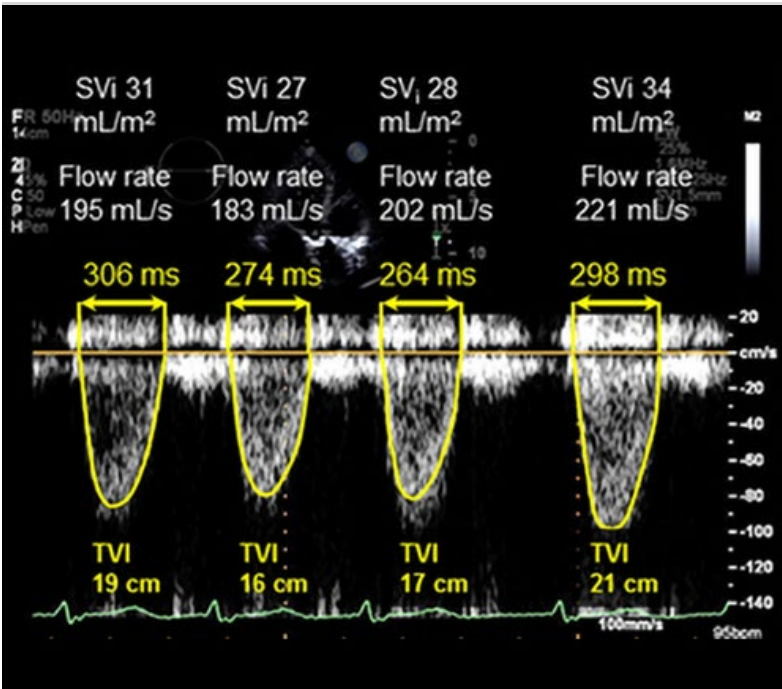

Single-highest signal obtained during atrial fibrillation more accurately identifies aortic stenosis

Research on the significance of high transvalvular gradients in atrial fibrillation low-gradient aortic stenosis indicates aortic stenosis severity is underestimated when the mean gradient is obtained during atrial fibrillation.
