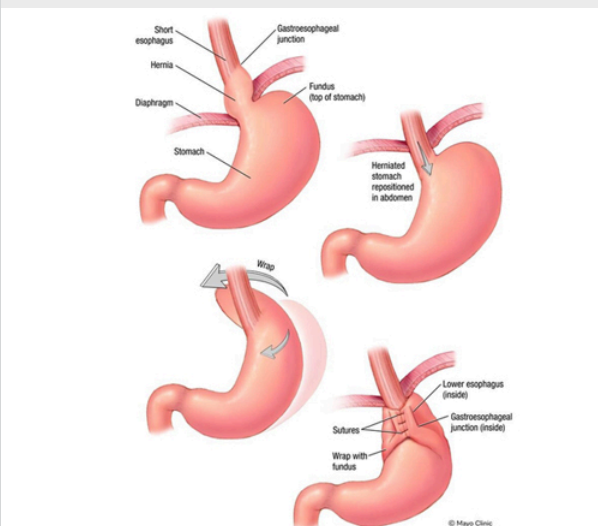

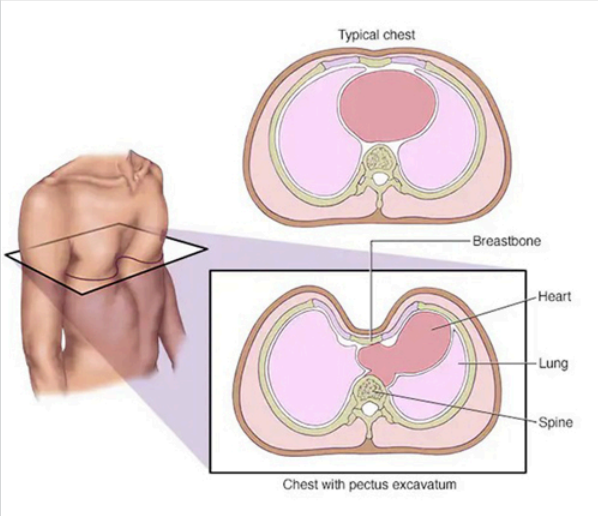

3D implants improve chest wall appearance

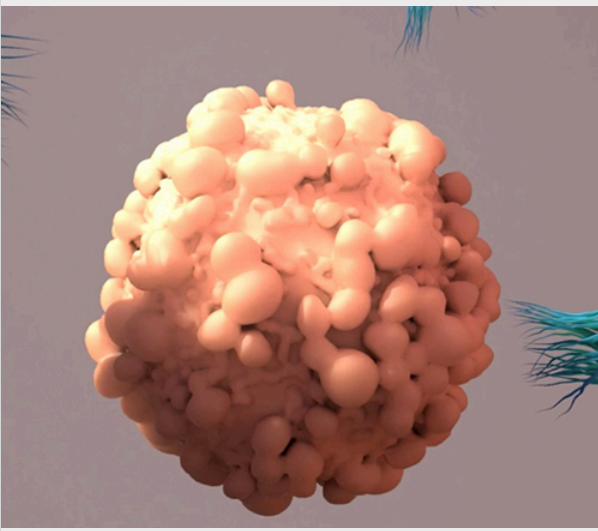

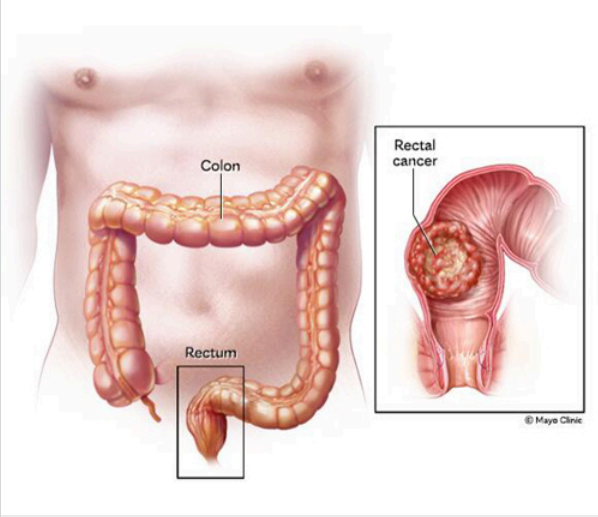
