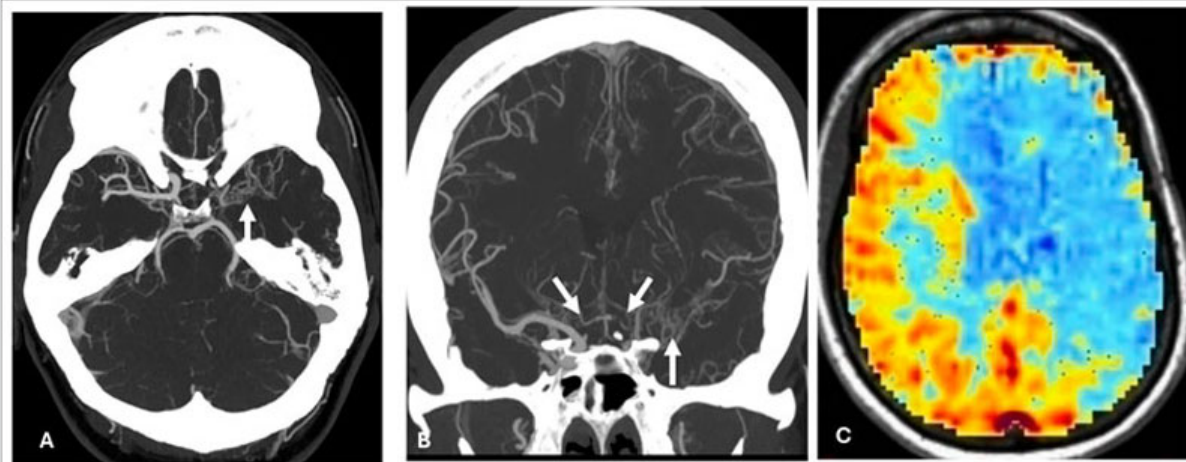
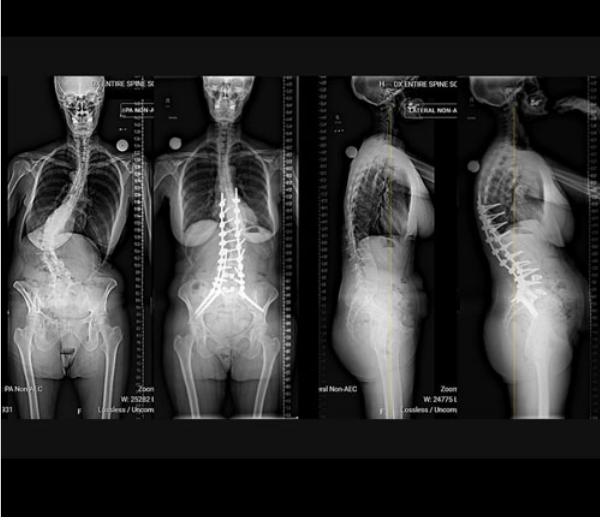

Subspecialized neurosurgeons use predictive analytics, computerized simulations and other tools to provide personalized care. The goal is lasting repair that improves quality of life.

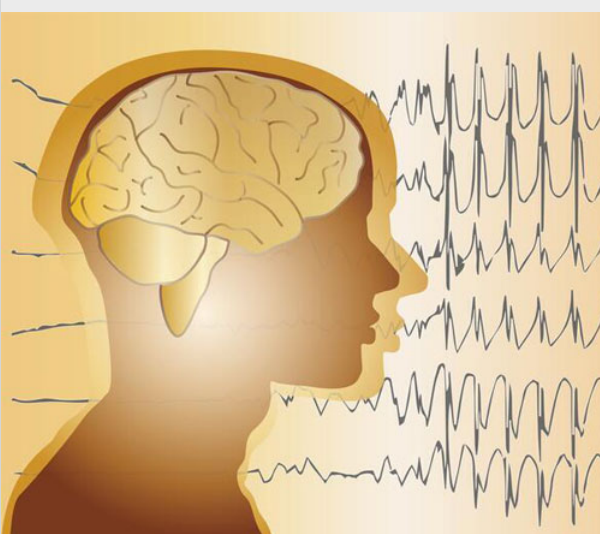
