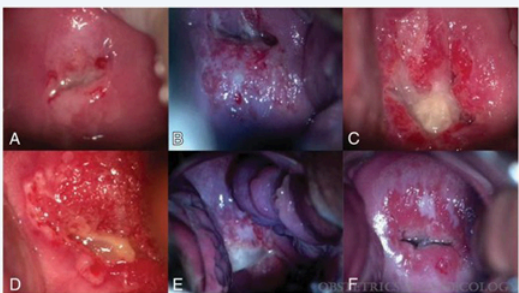

During pregnancy, cervical cancer risk can be glossed over and delay diagnosis – contributing to 40% of patients who are diagnosed without prior screening. Pregnancy offers a unique opportunity to optimize screening.

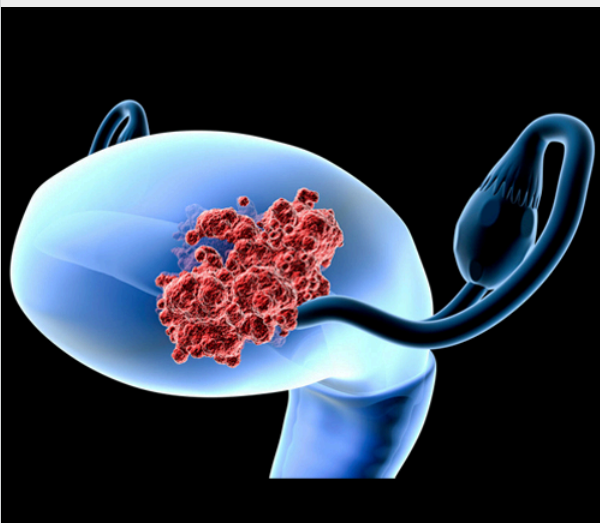
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Research



Molecular classification alone is insufficient for prognosis of stage 3C endometrial cancer

Mayo Clinic researchers wondered if molecular classification would account for recurrence-free survival variability in patients with endometrial cancer. Study findings published in the International Journal of Gynecological Cancer revealed that a difference in recurrence-free survival based on molecular class was not present.
