




MiST in vitro fertilization allows success at lower cost

A reduced-cost, mostly oral medication in vitro fertilization method used in the 1990s with low success now has favorable outcomes for motivated parents due to a new methodology.

Hyperthermic intraperitoneal chemotherapy (HIPEC)



HIPEC not a beneficial addition for platinum-sensitive recurrent ovarian cancer

Secondary cytoreductive surgery (CRS) plus HIPEC followed by carboplatin cycles didn't demonstrate greater benefit compared with CRS followed by carboplatin cycles for patients with platinum-sensitive recurrent ovarian cancer.


