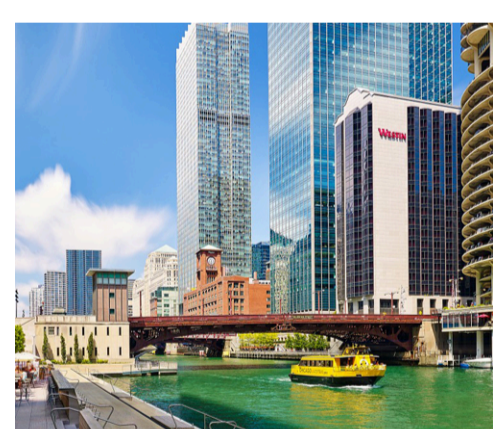


22nd Annual Women's Health Update

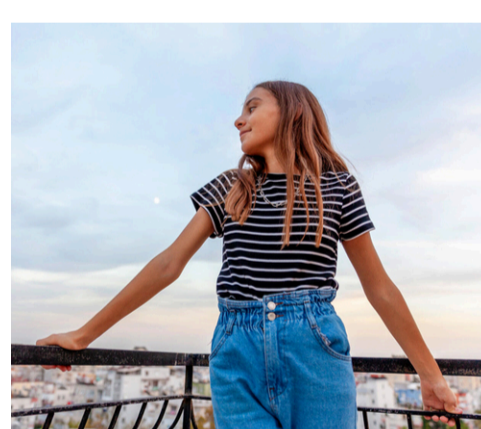
