Research Fellowship

The Department of Emergency Medicine at Mayo Clinic offers a Clinical Research Fellowship designed for residents and/or graduates of certified residency programs in emergency medicine. The goal of the fellowship is to provide a sound background in the principles and practice of clinical research for physicians who plan a career in academic emergency medicine. We offer a 2-year program that incorporates a Master's degree in Clinical and Translational Science (MS) from the Mayo Clinic Center for Clinical and Translational Sciences. Fellows will plan and conduct original clinical research and prepare a Masters Thesis under the close and regular supervision of experienced researchers (Doctors Erik Hess, MD, MSc; M. Fernanda Bellolio, MD, MS; Ronna Campbell, MD, PhD; Molly Moore Jeffery, PhD). Collaboration with experts from other departments within Mayo Clinic will be facilitated as needed to ensure a strong multidisciplinary mentorship team. Fellows will have limited clinical responsibilities working as junior faculty, will have no teaching or administrative responsibilities, and can expect a highly competitive annual income.

Application Process

Please note that we can only accept applications from those who will graduate from an ACGME accredited emergency medicine training program prior to beginning the fellowship on July 3 of each academic year. We will not accept applications from physicians without these credentials or those whose training was in another discipline. The annual deadline for applications is January 31 with an expected start date of July 3.
