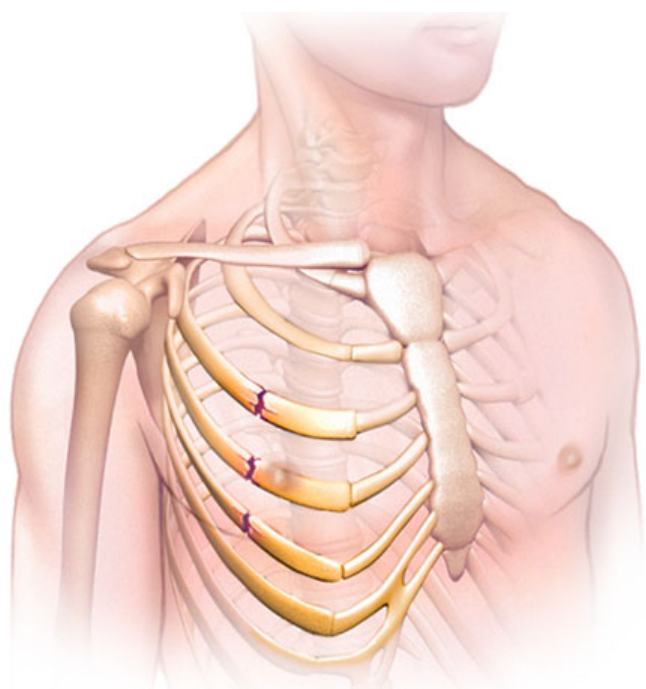

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Mechanical Ventilation Online Course

April 21, 2026, to April 20, 2028

This course addresses ventilatory support across acute respiratory failure. It emphasizes lung- and diaphragm-protective strategies, ARDS management, ventilator modes and prevention of ventilator-induced lung injury, integrating updated ARDS definitions and real-time bedside tools such as ultrasound.

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
