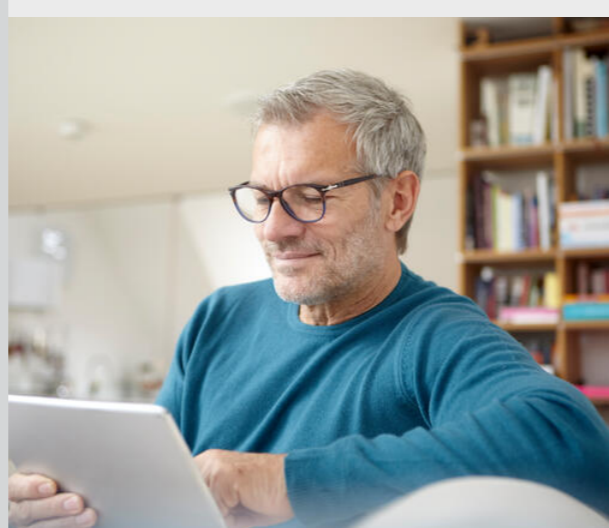

Intravesical chemotherapy, gene therapy and immune-activating treatments are reshaping care for BCG-unresponsive non-muscle invasive bladder cancer.

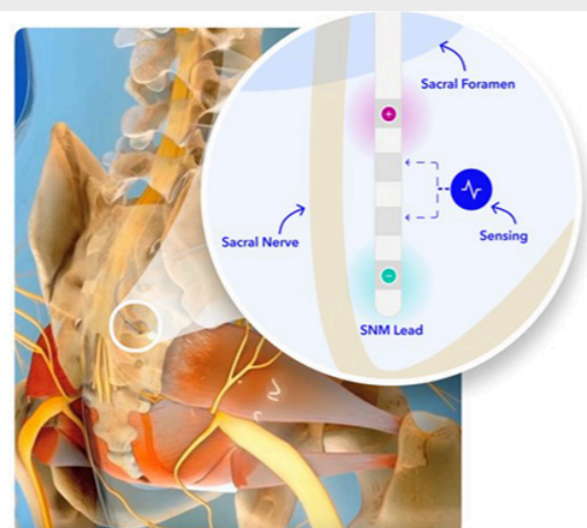

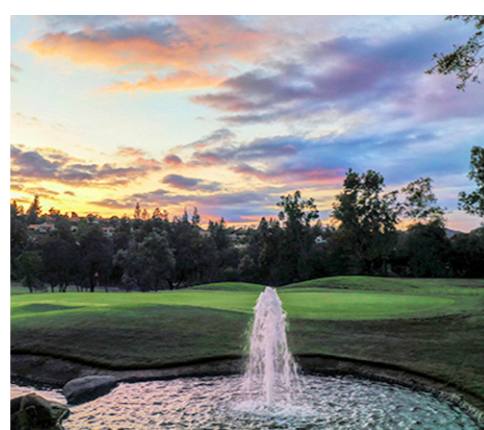
