

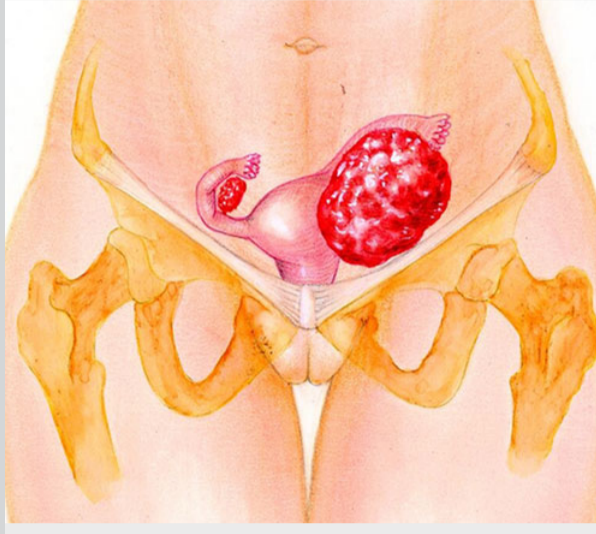

### Genetic mutations and ovarian cancer risk

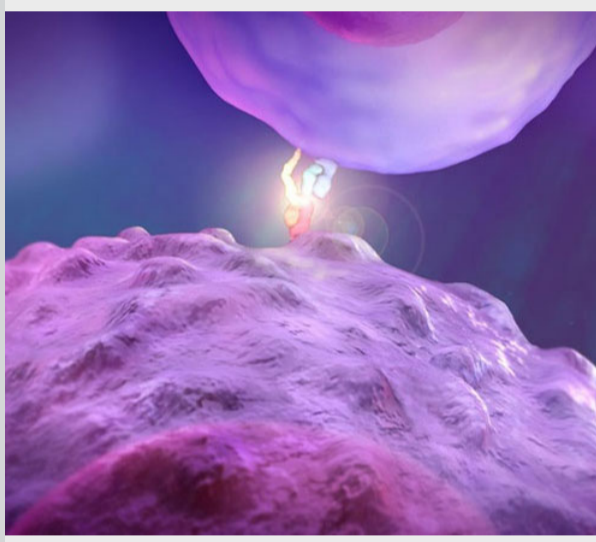

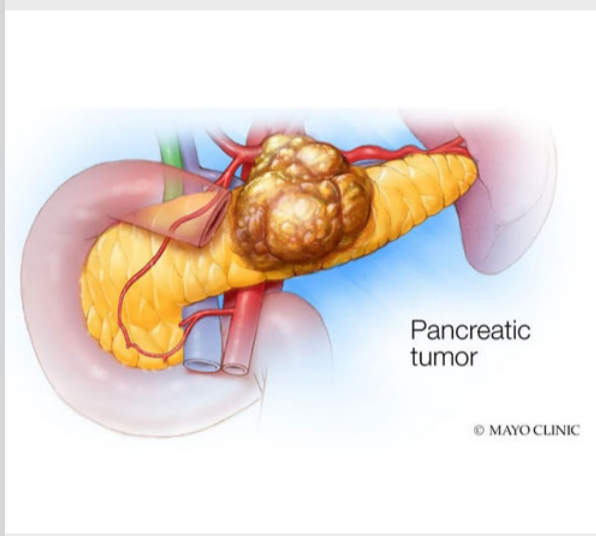

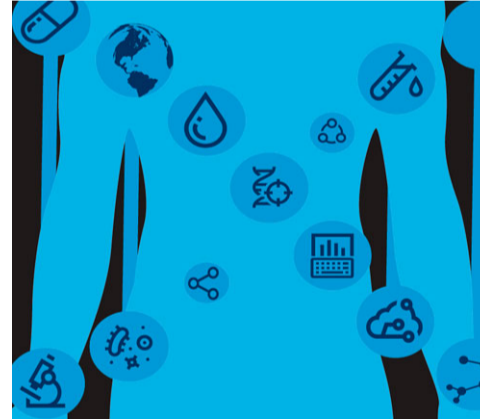


### 9th Mayo Clinic Symposium on Immuno-Oncology and Tumor Microenvironment Crosstalk 2022
